

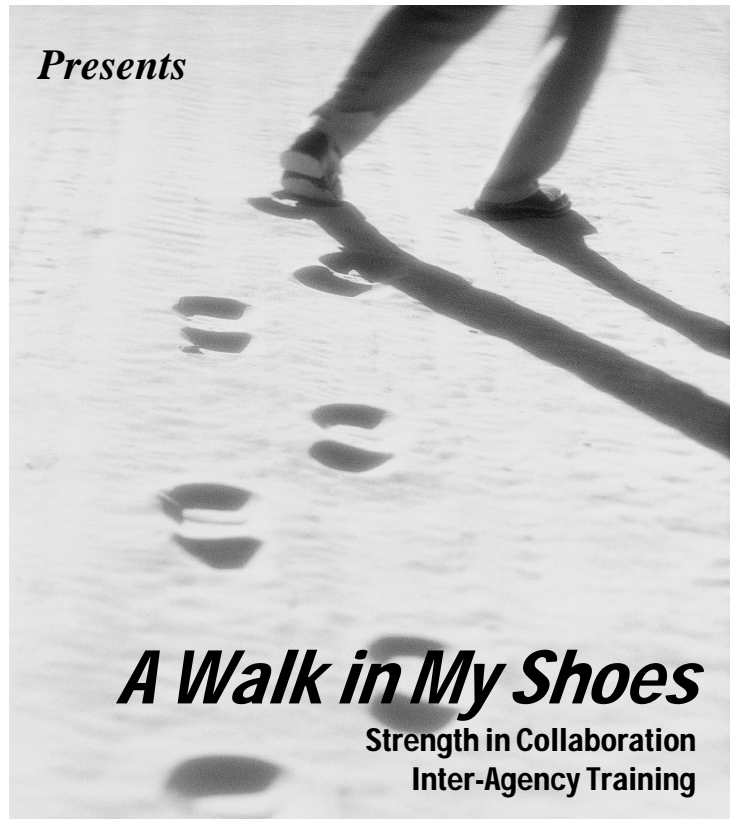

Vallée reveals that in the seven-year period from 2000 to the end of 2006, the total of all U.S. military and law enforcement deaths were 4,588. The combined total of all Canadian military and law enforcement deaths in the seven years was 101.

In that same period, more than 8,000 women in the U.S. and more than 500 in Canada were shot, stabbed, strangled, burned, or beaten to death by the intimate males in their lives.
