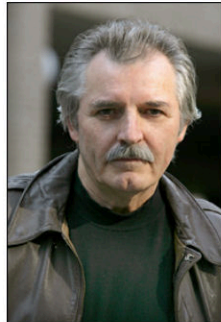


The **War** on Women
